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USAF Police Alumni Foundation Scholarship Application

The <u>USAF Police Alumni Foundation</u> (USAF PAF) is excited to announce our 2024 Scholarships Program in support of USAF AD, AFR and ANG Air Police, Security Police, Security Forces and CATM members, and their immediate family members who wish to further their education by pursuing a college degree or training at a vocational/technical school.

The USAF PAF Scholarships are open ONLY to the member, spouse, or eligible dependent child (an eligible dependent child is a child who is at least 17 years of age but has not yet reached their 26th birthday) who are eligible to apply. Qualifying applicants must be currently serving or have served honorably in the USAF as an Air Police, Security Police, Security Forces or CATM member or be an immediate family member of the sponsor. Family members who live outside the qualifying member's immediate household may not be eligible unless they are in residence while enrolled in and attending an accredited college, university, or trade school. Three (3) scholarships in the amount of \$2,000.00 each will be awarded this year to the selected candidates. The scholarships will be awarded regardless of status (member/dependent/veteran) of those that submit applications by the deadline and meet all criteria as noted below. *Please note that scholarship winners from the past 2 years are not eligible to compete this year.*

The \$2,000 scholarship shall be used in the academic year following completion of the award. The scholarship may be paid directly to the accredited college/university or vocational/technical school of the awardee's choice, or provided to the awardee to cover academic expenses, such as lab fees, books, etc.
